PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Traffic safety in the mornings and afternoons is a major concern at our school. Our primary concern is to keep Chatom students safe and **WE NEED YOUR HELP**.

<u>PLEASE</u> observe the following SAFETY RULES when transporting your student(s):

Students **should not arrive prior to 7:15 am or be on campus after 3:15pm** (1:10 on minimum days) unless they are enrolled in an afterschool program. There is no campus supervisor on duty outside of these hours.

The parking lot speed limit is **5 mph.**

Students **must enter and exit cars at the curb by the bell**. Please make sure they cross the street at the crosswalk. Please do not allow your students to cross the parking lot by the gate or bus lane. If you park outside the fence, please escort your child to the sidewalk area. The district office parking lot is for district visitors only. Student drop off and pick up will continue to be through the front entrance only.

Traffic in the parking lot is **ONE-WAY**. Please do not enter from the exit or back up in the parking lot. Exiting the parking lot onto Clayton Road is a right turn only at posted times.

Please do not misuse or block the handicapped parking spaces.

Please **observe all traffic laws** including no parking/loading in the red zone, passengers must wear seat belts, no driving over island, hands free cell phone use.

Please wait at the front of the school for students to be dismissed. Classroom visitors must check in at the office.
